

Social Security Card Number Breakdown

The Social Security account number consists of three sets of digits which are separated by a dash. The first three digits are known as the AREA number, the second two digits are the GROUP, and the last four digits are the SERIAL NUMBER. The first three digits are the only ones of concern.
